SBA Headquarters (HQ)

HQ is a historic brick building located in White Springs, just off of I-10 and I-75. The building has a full kitchen and showers and has served as SBA's home for over 25 years. HQ is a comfortable place to relax after a great day of riding, hiking or paddling. SBA members can use HQ with prior arrangement.



SBA is steps away from the famous Stephen Foster Folk Cultural Center State Park, located on the banks of the Suwannee River. With a full service campground, the state park is the site of many of our events. Foster's Hammock mountain bike trail, created by SBA, is also located in the park.

Our Mountain Bike Trails

Seven trails in the White Springs area offer over 50 miles of great and diverse single track for all skill levels. Created and maintained by SBA, trails are on Suwannee River Water District Management or state park land. Anderson Springs and Big Oak trails are near Ellaville. SBA trails are signed. Maps and QR codes can be downloaded from the SBA website.

Suwannee Valley Road Bike Routes

SBA has over 270 miles of scenic, low traffic country roads routes that are well marked. Maps with QR codes and route descriptions can be downloaded from the SBA website.

Hiking in White Springs

The scenic **Florida Trail** runs along the banks of the Suwannee River through White Springs and the state park. There are also other special hikes to enjoy. Many of our events offer hiking opportunities in the beautiful and pristine countryside. Hiking maps can be downloaded from our website.

Suwannee River Paddle Trips

These may be one-day or multi-day paddles; some scheduled during our events. Bring your own kayak/canoe or rent one from a local outfitter to fully enjoy the natural beauty of this scenic river.
